# Semarang flooded, February 2021

Several parts of Indonesia are prone to natural disasters. In the first two months of 2021 there were floodings on the islands of Sumatra, Java, Kalimantan and Sulawesi.

The Indonesian government claim that the sudden floodings of Kota Lama (the old city) in Semarang and of the various other regions were caused by extreme rain fall and tidal floods. Based on precipitation and other hydrological data, it can be concluded that it is a 50-year cycle according to Basoeki Hadimoeljono, Minister of Pubic Services and Housing.

Three pumps were used to pump the flood's water from the area into the Semarang River.

Dr Darmayanti told us that due to the flood, water entered the houses in Semarang, so the families needed to move to a different place. One family of the adoption children had to be isolated. The grandfather who had cared



for the children had died of corona.

Almost 10 families can't work in the informal sector because the town is in lock down. With the flood, these families are hit extra hard. The town is in lock down, everybody has to stay at home. The water level is at the height of

50 cm. With the help of rubber boats, provided by the government, the families are moved.

We are grateful that we could help these families somewhat with the bi-monthly donations for the food packages.

## From Mother Theedens, Batu – project:

Since April 2020 we have lived in fear of the corona virus in Indonesia. People are struggling because they have no job. Sellers can't sell because they have no money to buy materials.

We who believe in God are convinced that the Lord will not let his creatures suffer or abandon them (Psalm 34:9-10). What we can do to help them is not much. We pray that they may come closer to God and we tell them that they have to follow the health

protocol. Praise God that He opens His doors of love with the help of Pikulan Foundation. Extra aid will be provided to help the families with adoption children. From May 2020 until June 2021 each of these families can receive a food package. Each month we see tears



and gratitude for God's love and help via the Pikulan Foundation and the TBD-children's project. The food packages are God's answer to their confusion in this bad situation. God loves them and will not leave them. The Board of the TBD- children's project wants to thank the Board, promoters and all adoption parents for their cooperation, attention and the help that we may receive for the families. May God bless you all in your ministry, work and household.



# Message from Batulelling Sulawesi

Maria, former adoption child and project manager for Pikulan in Batulelling now, asks the following.

There has been a house fire in a neighbouring village, and because of that one family of 13 no longer has a roof over their heads. At present they live under a big sail, held up by walls of pallets placed on their sides. This family was hit twice, no home now and the corona virus. It means no work, no income. With the help of an unexpected donation of

the cooperation of deacons of the Protestant Church Haarlem, Pikulan has been able to provide a good roof over their heads. At the moment they are building a new house for these people! You can see the progress in the pictures. Pikulan Foundation is grateful to help in this way.



## Obituary Wilson Pilorobo

Last 20 February Wilson died in the Makassar hospital due to heart and kidney failure. He was buried two days later.

Fiona wrote that they had been hoping for his recovery, but that God had a better plan for him and for all of us. Wilson was the son of Mrs Pilorobo, our Usaha Mulia project leader on Bali. He was one of our board members, together with, among others, his sister Fiona. Wilson is survived by his wife and his son. He was only 45 years old. We got to know him as an enthusiastic young man, fond of laughing, with a big heart for children that are in need of help. He was in The Netherlands during the jubileum in 2009, together with many other project managers.

We wish the family much strength and God's comfort.

# Promotion for more sponsor parents

As you know, many children are sponsored by Pikulan by so-called adoption parents. At this moment 280 children. We are very grateful for this. The children find it wonderful to receive personal letters. We ask them to return a letter or drawing to the sponsor parents at least twice a year.

The financial aid, but also especially the contact with these sponsor parents, stimulates them to do their very best at school. Scientific research has shown that such children perform better.

But there are more than 100 children on a so-called waiting list. These children are already supported by Pikulan, from the net yield of our Charity shop, but these children are not yet connected with sponsor parents. We would like to change that very much, not in the least because our charity shop had to close and made less money, but also to create personal connections. Our promoters have started a promotion to find new sponsor

parents. Numerous emails have been written to esp. associations, and two regional newspapers in Friesland published press releases. We have already received a few responses.

For example, the Batu promotor could already re-assign all the children that were adopted by Mrs Jean from Jakarta. Mrs Jean died of corona. She sponsored 4 children via the TBD-children's project. In itself this is special, that children are sponsored by Indonesian parents. In Indonesia people keep it a secret as much as possible when someone has corona infection, because they feel it is a disgrace. TBD received the news via someone who knew the family well. We are glad that

the children have found an adoption parent in The Netherlands.

**We ask all the readers of our newsletter: Would you like to become an adoption parent of a child or of another child? Or could you ask your relatives perhaps?**


It costs 16 euros a month up to 12 years, and 20 euros a month up to 18 years.
